

CATNB facilitates credit transfer and articulation arrangements among NB post-secondary institutions, and also promotes the appropriate and effective use of prior learning assessment and recognition (PLAR)

Efforts have been devoted to facilitate articulation and transfer agreements between NB colleges and universities:

- LPN BN Transfer NBCC & CCNB to UNB and UdeM
- Signed MOU for Engineering Transfer among UNB, NBCC, CCNB & UdeM
- Applied degree in managing financial services, Marketing, Distribution
 Management, Technology, Information and leadership, and Biotechnology.



Moving Forward

Student transferability / mobility enhancement is measured via an annual statistical benchmarking report. Our annual stats have been showing continuous increase in transfer credits awarded, since the creation of CATNB. And the focus for the future is to:

- Continue Increasing the number of Articulation Agreements and New Pathways to credentials
- Create an electronic transfer of transcripts mechanism among member institutions
- Benchmarking of PLAR Services for orientation of the PLAR member organizations to the CAPLA PLAR Quality Assurance Standards manual and use of Common Terminology
- Continue expanding the Credit Transfer Portal to include transfers into NB from outside the province and country, as well as links to PLAR services
- Continue collaborating with other Canadian CATs and jurisdictions to enhanced Pan-Canadian mobility among our Post-secondary partners





Moving Forward

Based on an exchange session at the CATNB AGM in April, key barriers for improving the future were identified, concluding that:

We must continue to avoid competition and strengthen our partnerships, so that students opt for the province whether they choose institution X or institution Y, transferability leads the way.
