About ONCAT

- Launched in 2011
- Non-profit funded by TPA from Ministry
 - Funding extended to 2019
- Member-based organization
 - 24 colleges & 21 universities
- Students will experience ease of mobility among publicly assisted postsecondary institutions





Support institutions...

- Ontario PSE system not built for transfer
- Pathway project funding -> increased collaboration
 -> change in culture

...to create opportunities for students

- 1500+ pathways / 180,000+ course equivalencies
- 80% of diploma students -> degree
 - 60% -> high affinity degree
- ~55,000 students/year transfer


